

Board of Revision Appeals Can Be Filed for Free

Michael E. Kovack, Medina County Auditor, reminded homeowners that valuation appeals can be filed by property owners at the 3rd floor office of the County Administration Building, 144 N. Broadway, Medina. Some residents may receive a letter from a tax service company offering tax appeal services for a fee. That is unnecessary—the appeal can be filed at no cost in the Auditor’s Office or through the mail.

The Board of Revision Form can be downloaded from “Forms” on Auditor Kovack’s website at www.medinacountyauditor.org. The completed form must be **RECEIVED in the Medina County Auditor’s Office by March 31, 2011. The homeowner will then be notified of the date for the appeals meeting.**

Auditor Kovack stated, “It is really unnecessary for a property owner to pay someone to file the Board of Revision form. It is a simple and straight-forward format and can be mailed or hand delivered to the office.”
