Dr. Milton says problems with baby teeth, misalignment, or decay can damage permanent teeth, and intervention at an early stage can prevent severe problems later on.

Dr. Milton was born and raised in Athens, Greece, but his dream to become a Pediatric Dentist brought him to Ohio at an early age. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Biochemistry from Youngstown State University before attending Case Western Reserve University School of Dental Medicine. He graduated with a Doctor of Dental Surgery Degree (DDS) and was the only one in his class to be selected for the Pediatric Dental Residency Program of Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital in Cleveland. There, he spent two years treating infants, children and young adults in conjunction with several other medical specialties, and was awarded the position of Chief Resident. Upon completion of his training, Dr. Milton

was invited to join the faculty of Case Western Reserve University, and was the first dentist to receive a Multidisciplinary Clinical Research Grant from the Cleveland Clinic, enabling him to conduct cutting-edge research in the field of pediatric dentistry.

Dr. Milton is excited to bring his knowledge and expertise to the Brunswick area. He says he and his staff create a positive, nurturing atmosphere, and are committed to providing children excellent oral health care and orthodontic supervision as they grow. “I try to make each child (and their parents) relax and even have fun as I explain the procedures, while utilizing the most current techniques and technology available in pediatric dentistry today.”

Dr. Milton enjoys spending time with his family; wife, Jenny, and children, Marina, 6, and Alex, 3. They live near Brunswick, and in their spare time love to travel, and play video games.
